# **WEEE-PARK**

WEEE·PARK is a state-of-the-art Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) treatment and recycling facility located on a 3-hectare site in EcoPark, Tuen Mun. It signifies Hong Kong Government's commitment towards sustainable use of resources and provides an essential piece of infrastructure in support of the implementation of the producer responsibility scheme (PRS) on WEEE (WPRS) to ensure proper recycling and disposal of regulated electrical equipment under the scheme.

WEEE·PARK adopts German advanced technologies to turn air conditioners, refrigerators, washing machines, televisions and computer products, through a series of detoxification, dismantling and recycling processes, into valuable secondary raw materials, while exercising stringent control over hazardous components contained in WEEE. It also features a rainwater harvesting system, a solar water heating system, and green architectural elements designed to maximise use of natural lighting and ventilation. In addition, WEEE-PARK has a green coverage ratio of 30 percent, and is aiming to achieve the BEAM Plus Gold rating.




