## Experience Sharing Seminar for A Study Mission to Taiwan Focusing on Waste Management

### Synopsis

In late May 2010, a total of 26 participants joint a study mission organised by the Hong Kong Productivity Council to visit Taiwan. Through seminars (by local officials and academics) and various site visits, this study mission learnt how (a) ordinary citizens sorted their municipal solid wastes at sources; (b) contractors collected municipal solid waste; (c) two private companies recover valuable resources from waste electrical and electronic equipment, (d) food wastes were composted; (e) how municipal solid wastes were incinerated in two waste to energy incinerators. The speaker would like to share with you what he encountered during this study mission.

### Speaker

Dr. CHEUNG got his Bachelor of Science and Master of Philosophy Degrees from Chinese University of Hong Kong; Doctor of Philosophy Degree from The University of Manchester Institute of Science and Technology, England. Before joining City University of Hong Kong, Dr. CHEUNG worked for Water Research Centre in England, Hong Kong Baptist University and Environmental Protection Department of the Hong Kong SAR Government. At the present moment, Dr. CHEUNG is a member of Hong Kong Society for Quality and a Fellow Member of Hong Kong Institution of Environmental Impact Assessment. He is a member of the Appeal Board established under the Environmental Impact Assessment Ordinance of Hong Kong; a member of Advisory Committee on the Quality of Water Supplies of the HKSAR Government and a member of the Accreditation Committee for the Quality Seawater Assurance Scheme established by the Food and Health Bureau of the HKSAR Government. Dr. CHEUNG currently teaches Environmental Toxicology, Environmental Pollution, Environmental Control and Waste Treatment, Environmental Impact Assessment and Integrated Waste Management.
