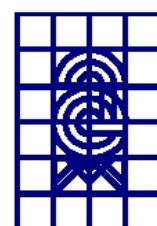

## REGISTRATION FEE

Hong Kong Programme : HK\$1,800. The fee will include a copy of Symposium Proceedings, lunches and tea breaks (27-28 Sept), welcome dinner ( 27 Sept ) , technical visit and transportation to Ferry Pier to Macau. (For HK delegate who participate in the event in Macau, a surcharge of HK\$250 is required for ferry ticket to Macau.)

Macau Programme : HK\$500. The fee will include a lunch (29 Sept), dinner (28 Sept), technical visit and transportation to Guangzhou.

Guangzhou Programme : HK\$750. The fee will include a lunch (30 Sept), dinner ( 29 Sept ) and technical visit. (Participants have to make their own transportation arrangement to their destinations upon completion of the entire Symposium.)

- Author (limited to one author per paper) whose paper is selected for presentation and inclusion in the Symposium Proceedings will be *waived* for registration fee; Author (limited to one author per paper) whose paper is selected for inclusion in the Symposium Proceedings would be eligible for *50% discount* on registration.
- The discount (or waive) for registration fee is sponsored by the organiser in HK and is only applicable to that part of the Symposium to be held in Hong Kong on 27-28 Sept 2010, but not to the remaining other parts to be held in Macau and Guangzhou.
