particular skills and experience are encouraged to lecture on these courses and workshops. HKWMA currently organises courses on Waste and Environmental Management with City University and Hong Kong Polytechnic University.

Website and Newsletter – information is disseminated to Members predominantly by email, the Newsletter and through the HKWMA website (www.hongkongwma.org.hk), which contains a library of information and resources available to Members.

Government Advisory – as the pre-eminent association concerned with waste, HKWMA frequently provides advice to government on their proposals and policies for the future management of waste in Hong Kong. Views of all HKWMA Members

are collected and presented by the ExCo to government. On behalf of the HKWMA, ExCo Members participate in project-specific "Focus Groups", provide comment on forthcoming legislation (we present to various LegCo panels) and are appointed to sit on government advisory committees.

Networking Opportunities – through organising social functions, such as the Annual Cocktail Reception and the AGM, Members are provided with opportunities for networking with the major players and stakeholders in Hong Kong's waste management industry in a relaxed and informal atmosphere.



會籍 Membership

本會會籍分為四類，包括機構、公共團體、個人及學生會籍，所有會費均非常合理。

機構會籍：供私人公司、合夥公司、政府、貿易團體及其他牟利機構申請。每個機構會籍可供不多於四名機構代表享用

公共團體會籍：主要供非牟利機構，如：專上學院及環保團體申請。每個公共團體會籍可供不多於兩名機構代表享用；

個人會籍：供18歲以上的人士申請；

學生會籍：供各專上學院的全職學生申請，會費全免。

會籍週年為每年的7月1日至翌年的6月30日。新會員如在中途入會，可享有會費扣減。

HKWMA membership comprises organisations, institutions, professionals and students working or interested in the field of waste management. There are four categories of membership, all at highly affordable rates:

Organisation Membership – for corporate entities, partnerships, government, trade associations and other profit-making organisations. Each organisation can designate up to four representatives.

Institution Membership – for non-profit making organisations such as tertiary educational institutions and green groups. Each institution can designate up to two representatives.

Individual Membership – for individuals aged 18 years or over.

Student Membership – for full-time students of tertiary educational institutions.

The membership year runs from 1st July to 30th June, however, new Members shall be entitled to a reduced membership fee if they join part-way through the membership year.

創會歷史

成立一個專注廢物管理的學會的構思早在1993年6月一個公開會議上提出。籌組學會的體制形式經多番討論，包括在海外或本地的專業學會中成立支部。最終在1993年9月及1994年4月的兩個會議上達成共識，支持創辦一個建基香港的獨立團體。就此草擬學會的創辦計劃書、預算及規則。

香港廢物管理學會於1994年8月30日正式註冊為社團，而創會會議亦於同年9月14日在香港太古廣場的港麗酒店順利舉行。

使命

投入廢物管理建設社會未來

宗旨

為達致創辦學會的使命，本會跟據六大宗旨，致力為會員謀取福利：

1. 促進高規格的香港廢物管理設計及營運標準，包括危險廢物及液體廢物；
2. 為參與及關注廢物管理的人士提供交流平臺，促進合作；
3. 舉辦有關廢物管理的會議、參觀、工作坊及研討會；
4. 與教育機構協辦培訓課程以提高各界對廢物管理的知識；
5. 組織訪學團以分享及交流廢物管理的經驗；
6. 發表意見及立場書以供討論各項廢物管理的議題；
7. 與本地、區域及國際廢物管理組織保持緊密聯繫。

Origins

The idea of forming an association dedicated to waste management was first discussed at an open meeting held in June 1993. Various forms of association were discussed, including attachment to existing local and overseas institutions. Two further open meetings, held in September 1993 and April 1994, confirmed the option of a free standing, locally based organisation, and agreed a draft prospectus, budget and association rules.

The Hong Kong Waste Management Association (HKWMA) was registered as a society on 30 August 1994 and the inaugural General Meeting was held at the Conrad Hotel on 14 September 1994.

Mission

“Working Towards Effective Waste Management for a Sustainable Society”



Objectives

To achieve its mission, the HKWMA developed seven objectives which it strives to fulfil for the benefit of its Members:

1. To foster high design and operational standards of solid waste management in Hong Kong, including hazardous waste management and liquid waste issues associated with solid waste management.
2. To encourage collaboration between all those concerned with and involved in solid waste management.
3. To organise meetings, technical visits, workshops and seminars on issues related to solid waste management.
4. To co-organise, in conjunction with local academic institutions, training courses in environmental and waste management, providing technical expertise from within the HKWMA.

學會運作

香港廢物管理學會為一個獨立及非牟利的專業組織，由學會章程監管其運作。在每年的週年大會中，選出一個包含十個常務委員的委員會。學會由會長負責牽頭，副會長、榮譽司庫、榮譽秘書、會員秘書及上屆的會長亦會協助。其他常務委員則負責安排一系列的工作及活動予會員參與。委員會中亦有增補委員，以提供額外的支援及資源。

香港廢物管理學會放眼於廢物管理中的議題非常廣泛，作為一個專業團體，學會旨在收集及交流廢物管理上實際及可行的經驗，以提高整體環境基礎的素質。

本會設有個人及團體會籍。除可獲取本地廢物管理市場最新動態資訊外，會員亦可透過本會與其他地區及世界性的組織聯繫。

本會亦與中國城市環境衛生協會 (CAUES) 及國際固體廢物協會 (ISWA) 有著長期及緊密的聯繫。

活動

技術會議：包括研討會及工作坊，旨在分享處理本地廢物的經驗。除了本地議題，本會亦時有邀請國內外專家，探討香港以外廢物管理的最新發展；

設施參觀及考察：深入探討本地及外國廢物管理設施的設計、操作、管理、處理及棄置的實例。；

會議：主要讓香港、東南亞地區及國際上參與廢物管理的人士聚首一堂，分享一系列廢物管理的問題及經驗。每年一度的「海峽兩岸固廢管理論壇」，2009年亦由本會在香港主辦。



5. To organise study trips to promote the exchange of practical information and ideas on solid waste management.
6. To prepare working papers for discussion and to address solid waste management matters.
7. To establish and maintain contact with local, regional and international organisations whose activities are related to solid waste management.

Operation

The HKWMA is an independent, non-governmental and not-for-profit organisation, and is governed by a Constitution. It is run by an Executive Committee (the ExCo) who comprise ten Members elected to office at the Annual General Meeting (AGM). The HKWMA is led by the Chairperson who is supported by a Vice-chairperson, Honorary Treasurer, Membership Secretary, Honorary Secretary and a Past-chairperson.

Other ExCo Members are responsible for organising a range of activities that are of benefit to the Members. Members may also be co-opted onto



the ExCo to provide additional support and resources.

The HKWMA focuses on a broad spectrum of waste management issues. As a professional body, it aims to gather and exchange practical experience and know-how in the waste management field with a view to sustaining and enhancing the quality of environmental infrastructure.

Membership of HKWMA is a means for individuals and organisations concerned with waste management to keep abreast of developments both in Hong Kong and elsewhere. It serves the local community and aims to maintain relationships with similar

organisations in the region and the rest of the world.

HKWMA has developed strong links with the well-established International Solid Waste Association (ISWA) and with the China Association of Urban Environmental Sanitation (CAUES).

Activities

Technical Meetings – including seminars and workshops, to address contemporary solid waste issues in Hong Kong. In addition to local professionals and specialists, overseas experts are also invited to make presentations on the latest international issues to ensure Members are kept abreast of the latest developments.

Field Trips / Technical Visits – organised to allow Members to study the design, construction and operation of facilities for the collection, handling, management, treatment and disposal of solid wastes in Hong Kong and elsewhere in the Region. Overseas study trips enable the exchange of environmentally sound technologies

and management principles to Members.

Conferences – organised to provide Members with exposure to a wide range of local, regional and international issues in the field of waste management. Our close links with CAUES include organising the Two-Coast Forum on Sustainable Solid Waste Management, which is being hosted by HKWMA in Hong Kong in 2009.

Training Courses – organised to provide training in practical aspects of waste management and technologies with special emphasis on issues relevant to the local environment. Members with
