Programme Highlight

Chemical Waste Treatment Centre (CWTC)

Located in Tsing Yi, the **Chemical Waste Treatment Centre (CWTC)** is Hong Kong's premier integrated facility for hazardous waste management, which has been in operation since 1993 and adopting state-of-the-art technologies for chemical waste treatment. Apart from handling locally generated chemical waste, the CWTC also functions as a designated reception facility as stipulated under the MARPOL Convention, for marine pollutants (MARPOL waste) generated from on-going vessels; and for treating clinical waste under the Clinical Waste Control Scheme since August 2011. To enhance the CWTC's operation, several new treatment systems have been built in the current follow-on contract, including Clinical Waste Sterilization System (CWSS), Pressurized Gas Cylinder Discharge System (PGCDS), and a new incinerator (Replacement Incineration System) with waste-to-energy recovery function.

We invite you to join our upcoming visit to explore this sophisticated plant. Participants will gain first-hand insight into advanced waste treatment processes, including **high-temperature incineration**. This technical tour offers a unique opportunity to see how Hong Kong manages complex waste streams to protect our local ecosystem.

Notes to be attention:

- All participants **must** wear long-sleeved attire to cover arms & legs (No short & skirt)
- Open-toed footwear and slippers are strictly prohibited;
- Due to the limited parking spaces & some construction works, no on-site parking is provided
